April - Water

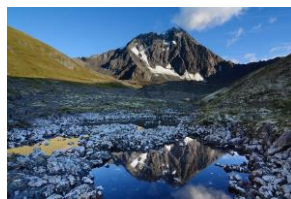
May - Wild flowers
