A taste of summer	This entry stimulated my taste buds; the subject looks so real I could eat it. Your composition and arrangement set against the black background works really well. A little underexposed though.	3rd
Apple Acres	A good attempt however as you have taken this as an all encompassing landscape shot I feel it lacks any focus point on which the eye can rest. Also the colours are quite subdued. <i>Remember less is often more.</i>	
Autumn Fruits	A good attempt at this grab shot. Quite innovative and good composition	
Cockney Stairs	A lovely simple arrangement set against the light but sympathetic coloured background enhancing the colours of the fruit. The shadows cast by the fruit brings life to them	HC
Exotic Fruit Stall	A simple but effective grab shot taken at an angle to give perspective. A good attempt	
Fruits of the Forest	I'm nuts about this one. An innovative and creative shot. Lovely well balanced colours make this a strong contender although a little underexposed.	HC
Grow your own	A good attempt but the lack of a single focal point takes the eye in differing directions reducing interest. The colours being somewhat flat makes the subject and supporting area feel undefined, blending into each other.	
Hanging Fruit	A good attempt. Good detail including the strands of webs and nice bokeh making the fruit stand out. Maybe underexposed.	
Harvest	A lovely array of colours and shapes makes you feel that this harvest time and autumn is here. It arouses the senses although the contrast is too high and exposure too little	
I think I've got everything on display	You certainly have! I like they great array of colours and shapes creating interest. It is just a pity that there are so many distractions such price labels etc. <i>Less is often more!</i>	
Limes	It's the simplicity of this composition that makes it such a strong image. Had you brought out the green of the skin and pale yellow of the inside it would have been even more striking.	
Market Stall	The amount of clutter dilutes the interest here. I realise that you probably wanted to show the subject in context but in doing so watered down the impact sadly.	
Pyracanthas berries	Good framing of these colourful berries against a well blurred background makes the subject stand quite out well.	
Ripe for picking	Nice and simple but effective. Subject is a little underexposed I feel which is a pity. A little brighter subject would have given it more punch. Lovely crisp shot though.	
Ripening Tomato	An imaginative shot with colourful fruits showing good detail however I feel it is let down by the shadows being too severe and the angle it's taken at makes me feel uncomfortable. Sadly the creased background material distracts the eye.	
Rustic Apples	A beautiful composition, strong colours and detail set against an uncompromising black background allowing the subject to stand out magnificently. The eye naturally falls upon the subject, although this is slightly under exposed.	1st
